PLEASE NOTE:

***Food Animal students must complete AEB3133 Principles of Agribusiness Management.**

***Food Animal students must also complete an additional 6 credits (minimum) of Approved CALS elective courses.**

For a course to be eligible as an approved CALS elective, it must be outside the “ANS” department, 3000/4000 level, and be within a department housed within the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences. (See Approved CALS Practicum list for more information)

***ANS4941 Full-Time Work Experience Internship must be completed prior to graduation.** Generally, students will complete internships in the summer term between their junior and senior year; however, students may complete the experience in any semester. Experience must be **pre-approved** after transfer admission and be a **minimum** of eight weeks in length, 40 hours per week worked.

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
